The Application Process

Please review the following process to decide if you'd be a good fit for the Youth Tour program!

High school juniors with a minimum of 2.5 GPA must answer the provided essay question, submit a resume that demonstrates leadership, extracurricular/school activities, and community service and complete the Youth Tour application.

A panel of judges will interview the top 20 finalists at the Baldwin EMC corporate office in Summerdale.

Four students will be awarded trips to Montgomery, Alabama, and Washington, D.C., and a college scholarship.





THE SCHOLARSHIP

Baldwin EMC will provide each Youth Tour winner with a \$750 nonrenewable scholarship to an accredited institution after recipients pass all required exams and graduate from high school.

TEACHER INCENTIVE

Students will list the name of a teacher who has made an impact on them during high school on their application. Teachers of winning students will receive an award of \$500 for educational classroom materials.

The Essay
