ENROLLED, House Joint Resolution,  
RECOGNIZING ALABAMA LINEMAN APPRECIATION DAY.

WHEREAS, the profession of lineman is steeped in personal, family, and professional tradition; and

WHEREAS, linemen are often first responders during storms and other catastrophic events, working to make the scene safe for other public safety heroes; and

WHEREAS, these brave men and women are essential to the protection of our communities and our nation; and

WHEREAS, linemen work with thousands of volts of electricity high atop power lines 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, to keep electricity flowing; and

WHEREAS, linemen must often work under dangerous conditions far from their families to construct and maintain the energy infrastructure of the United States; and

WHEREAS, linemen put their lives on the line every day, with little recognition from the community regarding the danger and difficulty of their work; and

WHEREAS, the 1st Monday in June would be an appropriate date to recognize as Alabama Lineman Appreciation Day; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we gratefully acknowledge the efforts of linemen in keeping power on and protecting public safety and, by copy of this resolution, we encourage all Alabamians to observe the 1st Monday in June as Alabama Lineman Appreciation Day.
